### CORTLAND COUNTY TRIVIA FROM THE CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY

In the last issue of the CAT, we asked if you knew the name of a popular park on Franklin Street.

By all accounts on file at CCHS, from about 1873-1895, there existed a little piece of Eden in the (then) Village of Cortland.



Over where the DPW is on South Franklin Street, there was a park which was about 3 acres. Its name was "Floral Fountain Trout Park," and it was owned by Hiram Curtiss Blodgett, one of Loren Blodgett's children. Loren founded Blodgett's Mills (as it was then called).

The perfectly manicured grounds made it a gorgeous slice of paradise where families picnicked, and young people would rendezvous. There was a circle about 90 feet in diameter which was surrounded by trees. A 10-12-foot promenade with a row of trees interplanted with flowers was there for strolling.

Other attractions included a maze of cedar hedges modeled after the maze at Hampton Court in London and two or three terrace walks that led to a brooklet and four ponds, all of which were full of speckled trout. There were hundreds of trout in the ponds! Two of the ponds had beautiful fountains which were fed by a hydraulic ram. In the center of the two upper ponds (30-40 feet in diameter) were large flower beds. Additional flower beds were scattered among the lower ponds and along the side, under the willow trees, and a narrow canal of running water afforded children a place to row in little boats. Visitors could go boating, play croquet, or picnic.

The park did well until Cortland put in a sewage system in 1893-1895. Ditches were dug along Port Watson Street, which diverted the springs which fed the trout ponds. Around the same time, the Cortland Homer Electric Car Company (the trolley) started their park over by the end of Elm Street. Transportation from the trolley made it an attractive alternative to the Floral Fountain Trout Park. The park struggled into the new century, but by 1940 it had all but disappeared.

### CREATURE FEATURE SLEEP WELL, STINKY

Now that colder temperatures are settling in, **striped** skunks are moving into their winter dens, which are often empty burrows adopted from foxes or woodchucks. It's not unusual for skunks to bunk together over the winter, providing added warmth through social thermoregulation. In preparation, the little stinkers have been building up their fat stores to help carry them through the cold months, and while they aren't true hibernators, they do enter a state of deep sleep known as torpor. During their dormancy, fat gets metabolized at a much slower rate than it does over the summer.

Over the last couple of weeks, I've noticed a lot of dead skunks on the roadways. Sadly, their search for good wintering quarters can lead them into the path of oncoming vehicles, so please be vigilant for skunk activity when driving after dark.

On a side note, skunks often get accused of spraying their stink at the least provocation. The fact is, skunks will only spray when they feel their life is in danger. The reason behind their hesitance to spray is that doing so leaves them defenseless for 10 days and vulnerable to attack from predators. Soon enough, our fragrant forest friends will be tucked away for the winter, along with their strong signature scent! Zzz...



The notion of new, shiny and expensive became the focus of big box retail chains who poured millions (billions) of dollars into advertising with the primary goal of drilling this very idea into the minds of anyone who watched television, listened to the radio, read magazines or shopped at any retailer.

As time went on, the target audience for retail holiday advertising (all holidays; not just Christmas) shifted from adults to children and youth: the age group often referred to as "tweens". Today, this still holds true and, thanks in large part to the growth of children/youth network television (Disney, Nickelodeon, Cartoon Network, etc.) and to social media platforms, the bulk of advertising dollars targets children, tweens, and teens with a relentless fury. Look at a wish list for any of these age groups and the chances of finding requests for handmade/homemade is very slim. In fact, finding individual wish list items that cost less than \$30-50 will be difficult!

How do we get back to normalizing handmade, homemade or secondhand gifts? Unfortunately, there is no one-size-fitsall "cure." However, common sense tells us that, as adults, we can model and practice behaviors that could help future generations.

- Limit exposure to advertisements when possible; this means reducing and closely monitoring screentime.
- Don't "overdo" gift giving for young children. Set a personallimit for number of gifts or the amount of money spent
  - on gifts. Demonstrate generosity by being kind, spending extra time with your children, and doing small things for them.
- Involve children in the gift-giving process by helping them make their own gifts. Model joyful

- acceptance of handmade, homemade or secondhand gifts.
- Teach generosity. Gift giving is packed full of opportunities for teachable moments. The key is communication! Talk to your children about mindful gifting and giving meaningful gifts. Ask children to consider questions like what the recipient might enjoy, what would be useful, and what they can afford. Encourage kids to participate in some way toward gift-giving, either by contributing money, helping to make a gift, or doing an "act of service" for a family member, such as planting flowers for Grandma!
- Donate! Before the holidays, have children sort through their toys and clothes to pick out items to donate to
- Model community giving and volunteering. Adopt a child in need for holiday gift giving.
- Consider "making memories" as a gift! Give your time, rather than a toy. A trip to the library, a play, the zoo...



JUST NORTH OF CORTLAND, IN the Town of Homer, is the newest VRBO in Cortland County. Because it is located on an alpaca farm, guests have the opportunity to plan a visit with the herd of 40 or shop for clothing, yarn, and gifts made from alpaca fiber in the farm store.

The VRBO is a recently remodeled and expanded 1900 farmhouse. There are three bedrooms, two full bathrooms and a loft space loaded with games and CDs for guest's entertainment. More info and pictures can be found at the VRBO website. It's a great place to stash visiting family for the holidays or any time.

In 2001, Ken and I bought three alpacas. Another soon followed. Over the years we have had as many as 92 livestock on the farm that have coexisted with chickens, guinea hens and cats. After 20+ years we have found that it is time to move on to focus more on the rental business and are downsizing our herd. In doing so, we will give discounts to guests who visit to spend a weekend deciding if they want to get into the business and purchase alpacas from us.

People who are interested in a hobby farm of their own can arrange for an Alpaca 101 class where we will teach all aspects of raising them. Some of the things we encourage prospective

owners to find out before buying are: what kind of dwellings and how much pasture space alpacas need, what kind of food they eat, how healthy they are in general, and what kind of medicines they need. This member of the camelid family does live comfortably in Central New York and can live between 16 and 22 years. We can also instruct on breeding. Raising livestock can be both rewarding and challenging. We have been fortunate enough to have had very few difficult births and sicknesses and have great veterinarians who help out when needed. Shots are given once a month to help keep a parasite away and shearing day every spring is a time for friends to help and have fun. It is exciting when a new baby (cria) comes into the world and it is fun to watch it grow and run around the pasture chasing after butterflies and guinea hens. Spring and Fall are always a busy time of year taking some of the young stock and herd sires to special events to show them off. There are some proud alpacas on this farm who have earned many blue ribbons for their strong frame and wonderfully soft fleece.


All of the fleece from the animals at Tartan Acres is sent away to be processed into warm and comfortable clothing or yarn which we sell in our farm store.






