HETHER IT IS A TOUR OF the Museum or an event in the newly renovated carriage house summer is a great time to check us out.

We are open for tours Thurs-Sunday. Come and see the home of Cortland's own industrialist Chester Wickwire. Chester built this home for his family; wife Ardell and sons Charles and Fredrick. The Wickwire family lived in this home from 1890-1973. Within these walls two young boys grew up and Fredrick the younger son then raised his own family here.

The 1890 House is renowned for its Belcher Mosaic Windows, its intricate parquet flooring(which has just been refurbished), and the fact that you can explore 4 floors and the turret while learning about the Wickwire family, life in Victorian times and beyond. The 1890 House also hosts paranormal tours and allows paranormal groups to book the House for their own investigations.

The 1890 House Museum and Carriage House is also a great place to host your family parties as well as small-medium events. New this year we have a new parlor space on the 3rd floor that may be used for book clubs, tarot readings, and





even use for the healing arts. The space can be rented out on its own or as part of a rental of the downstairs Fernery/Sunroom.

So this summer when you are thinking of a great day trip remember the 1890 House Museum. Cortland has some great places to eat, shop and additional museums like the CNY Living History Museum and Suggett House Museum.

CREATURE FEATURE I SPY WITH MY LITTLE EYE...

This region of New York boasts an impressive natural diversity. Whether you're fortunate enough to live here year round or are just visiting, there are many interesting animals and plants to see in the southern hills. Playing an outdoors form of "I spy" with young children can set the stage for a fun and educational family outing, as well as engage nature loving grown-ups. This

spring and summer, as you explore a shady forest trail, wander around a wetland, stroll through a sun-soaked meadow, or paddle along a lake or stream, see how many of these wild wonders you can "spy with your little eye!"

Early spring coaxes ephemeral flowers to bloom, including hepatica, bloodroot, trout lily, and spring beauty. Knowing their delicate purple, white, yellow, and pink blossoms are short lived makes them all the more lovely to behold. Look for these flowers alongside woodland trails.

One of the first dragonflies to take wing each spring is the chalk-fronted corporal, which (as an adult) has a mostly dark body with a pair of pale shoulder stripes. This handsome dragonfly can be found near open and wooded lakes, ponds and wetlands where it catches mosquitoes and other pests in mid-air.

Perhaps this spring or summer you'll "spot" a white-tailed deer fawn, which bears around 300 spots on its back and flanks! Please remember, mother deer intentionally leave young fawns

alone to keep them hidden from predators. If you spy a wee fawn curled up in the forest or field, resist approaching; instead, quietly leave the area without disturbing it and count yourself fortunate to have seen this magical sight.

Since the ban of DDT in 1972, bald eagles continue to make a comeback and it's no longer a rare event to see our majestic national bird soaring overhead. As fish are its primary prey, especially in spring and summer, the best place to spy an eagle is near a lake or river.

Keep your eyes open for these other plants and wildlife in your travels. In spring: wood violet, trillium, wild leek, eastern bluebird, chipping sparrow, mourning cloak butterfly, green frog, and red fox. In summer: oxeye daisy, wood fern, water lily, great blue heron, scarlet tanager, eastern swallowtail butterfly, leopard frog, and little brown bat.

A GREAT PLACE **TO START YOUR RACING CAREER**

THE FINGER LAKES MICROD CLUB has been around since 1983 and has given 803 children a chance to learn how to race a Microd during their 42 years of existence. There was a time in their history they were known as "The Finger Lakes Driving School" because most children that go there had no driving experience when they started. A second advantage for families was "You didn't have to Own a Microd" to participate in the program, families could rent one for the summer.

First is cost-it's affordable, it only costs \$545.00 for a full season that includes the Microd car & motor rental, insurance, and other club expenses.

Second, flaggers that are willing to explain mistakes to drivers, because how do you get better if you don't know what you did wrong.

Third, atmosphere, a parent doesn't have to have a great working knowledge of mechanics in order to compete, because members help each other when there's problems. Families help each other working on Microds.

Fourth, the club offers a chance to Try-out. Where a parent can bring their child and let them try driving a Microd for 10 laps or so, at no charge, before deciding to join the club or not.

Fifth, all cars must weigh-up to the heaviest car - driver combination in their class, and drivers draw chips each week to see which motors they
