CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

DID YOU KNOW THAT ONCE upon a time, there was an organization that provided a home for children who needed a place to live? That place was the King's Daughters Children's Home, and it was officially opened on May 17, 1906.

Members of the King's Daughter's recognized that there was a need in the community for children who needed care. They raised the funds needed to create a safe place and purchased the 1806 hotel located on Port Watson Street where the BOCES facility is today. The building was a historic one, having been "The Grand Hotel" in the village of Port Watson. It was a stagecoach stop in the early years of Cortland County and served the boatmen who traveled the Tioughnioga River. In the late 1800s, it was a home for aged women.

The first children to live at the home were two little boys, and during that first year, it provided a home to eighteen children. Children came to live at the home for a variety of reasons. Some were placed there by social agencies for unstable home conditions, through emergencies (like house fires), or by their parents or relatives who simply could not care for them. Some children stayed briefly while others stayed for years. There were often as many as 80-100 children living there at one time. The home was closed in 1958 due to the development of the foster care system which placed children in foster homes to keep them in a family environment. In the 52 years that the Children's Home was open, more than 1200 children passed through those doors. While it wasn't a perfect solution, it provided help to the youngest and

most vulnerable members of our community when they needed it most.





Most monument companies don't do any of the hands-on work anymore, Ty explains, they are mainly a middleman, selling you the monument and ordering it from a manufacturer already lettered and designed. It comes in a box and the monument company delivers it to the location. The family has no recourse if something is wrong, without waiting months for a replacement, if at all. Another major flaw in having it done at a factory, is there are many monument companies with orders in and it could take months to get your memorial and they charge per design and letter so there is no set price. When we sell a memorial and tell you the price, it includes all the lettering, design work and delivery, no hidden charges, we feel that is the fair way to do business, the family shouldn't be charged because their last name is three letters longer than the average. We design and engrave what we sell, along with offering on site lettering such as a final date, in cemeteries across Central New York. We have a large display at our main office in Scipio, and after looking for some time, found a perfect location in Cortland to open a sales office to service our families in our eastern service area at 1027 NY-13 (Tompkins St.) Cortland, right on the corner of Munson and Route 13. Since 2020, I am in constant communication with my wholesalers and have been to Vermont numerous times last year buying inventory to stay well stocked on our most popular monuments, we currently have over 500 monuments in stock and I am proud to say that we have the largest display in the area with this year will be no exception, in fact we will be expanding our Cortland office display this Spring, with some new granite colors that are quite appealing. HEN NY CONNECTS STAFF MEETS with groups, we often start our presentations by asking "Have you heard of NY Connects"? The response from the audience is often," I have heard of it but that's about all I know."? You might be surprised to learn that goldfinches are 100% vegetarian, even in the summer months. As we edge towards spring, the male finches will begin to turn bright yellow, while the females stay dressed in subdued plumage.

Downy woodpeckers are North America's smallest variety of woodpeckers. They have special feathers around their nostrils to keep wood chips out. Also, their bill is smaller than other woodpeckers - more like forceps at the tip - which enables them to extract insects and their eggs and larvae from within stems and other tight spaces.

Tufted titmice are among the first birds to warn others of a predator's presence. The alarm call of a titmouse fades in volume to make it sound as though it is moving away, proving that this familiar feathered friend is more than just a pretty face!




