ST. ANTHONY'S ITALIAN **FESTIVAL 2025 MAY 31 & JUNE 7-8**

NE OF THE AREA'S OLDEST and best loved events in Cortland County, The St. Anthony's Italian Festival, will kick-off Saturday May 31. The 120-year-old celebration is rich in both religious and cultural history. The festival can be traced back to June 13, 1905 when a 21- piece band, followed by Italian residents of the city, paraded through the streets of Cortland, with a statue of St. Anthony, to St. Mary's church where Mass was celebrated. The tradition of honoring the patron saint in this way has its roots in Italy.

The cultural aspects of the festival have become well known for delicious homemade Italian food. Kicking off the events is a Spaghetti Supper on Saturday, May 31, 4-7pm in the church hall on 50 Pomeroy Street, Cortland. Both eat-in or take-out options are available.

On Saturday, June 7, from 4 to 10pm, Italian favorites including sausage sandwiches, pizza, meatball subs, Utica Greens, Tomato Pie, Pizza Fritta, Gelato, and a variety of Dolci (Italian cookies /sweets) will be available. Live music, provided by Jenna Noelle & The Extras, and The Fall Creek Brass Band, is sure to have the crowd rocking and rolling. In addition, a prize wheel, raffles, and Italian novelties round out Saturday's activities. The evening concludes with a

spectacular fireworks display, which can be viewed from the

On Sunday, June 8, from 12:30 to 6pm the festival opens with the same delicious food, children's games, raffles, and a cake wheel. Live entertainment for the day includes The Steve Daniels Swingtet, Molly and the Ringwalds, and The Cortland Old Timers Band.

Highlighting the religious aspect of the festival is a 9:30 Mass Sunday morning featuring 13 young boys, dressed as monks, singing an Italian hymn honoring St. Anthony. This hymn, sung in Italian, often brings tears to the eyes, as parishioners remember, honor, and celebrate family members and friends who have passed.

The Mass concludes on an upbeat note when The Cortland Old Timers Band enters the sanctuary to play Caderna, a beloved Italian March. Their rendition of this traditional Italian march has the members of the church waving flags and banners, clapping hands, and swaying to the beat. CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

ID YOU KNOW THAT THE Town of Preble was named after Edward Preble?

Born in Massachusetts on August 15, 1761, Edward Preble was just sixteen years old when ran away to sea to escape farming life, and he joined a privateer out of Newburyport at the height of the American Revolution. He served as a midshipman in 1780 aboard the Protector, a Massachusetts State Navy frigate. The Protector destroyed Admiral Duff, a British merchant ship, and they took on board 55 survivors. Those captured were suffering from a fever and the crew of the Protector became infected as well. Preble had to take a leave to recover his health which would always remain troubled for the rest of his life.

In December of 1780, Preble had sufficiently recovered to rejoin the crew of the Protector, and the ship continued its attempts to capture British frigates, having some success before being captured in the spring of 1781. Edward Preble was taken prisoner and was exchanged for a captive British officer only when his father intervened by contacting a wellknown Loyalist to facilitate the exchange of prisoners.

Preble continued his service in the United States Navy until 1804, and he served aboard the USS Constitution, the USS Essex, and the USS Pickering. His naval career included not only the American Revolution, but also the Quasi War with France and the First Barbary War against the Ottoman Tripolitania (located around the present-day Libya).

Preble achieved the title of Commodore during his career, and it was he who established many of the rules and regulations of the United States Navy. Under his stern command, ships were maintained at the highest level of readiness and other commanding officers followed his lead. He was awarded the Congressional Gold Medal on March 3, 1805, for the 1804 attacks on Tripoli during the First Barbary War.

President Thomas Jefferson offered Edward Preble the command of the Navy in 1806, but his declining health prevented him from accepting, and he died the next year on August 25, 1807.

Preble, NY was one of the six original towns of Cortland County when it was established in 1808. Preble was carved from the town of Tully to become a part of the brand-new Cortland County and named after Commodore Edward
