



# **CREATURE FEATURE**DEER IN MYTHS & LEGENDS

RACKING DEER FAR BACK INTO ancient mythology, we find their trails intertwined with that of Artemis, the Greek goddess of wilderness. One tale tells of the hunter, Acteon, who used a stag's hide to sneak up on Artemis as she bathed in the forest. After discovering she had been spied upon, Artemis turned Acteon into a stag, which was hunted down and killed by his own hounds.

Deer are prominently featured in Celtic mythology. Scottish Highlands dwellers called them 'fairy cattle' and believed they were milked by magical mountain fairies. Certain Scottish folklore imbued deer with the ability to cross between human and supernatural realms; and in Celtic religion, the stag represented the god Cernunnos, or "The Horned One," who was often portrayed with antlers. An Irish legend tells of the heroic warrior Finn mac Cumhail who cornered a beautiful doe. When his hounds refused to kill it, he took the deer back to his land where she returned to her true form, that of a breathtakingly lovely woman named Sadhbh – and the two were wed.

Deer also traversed North America's mystical trails. In certain indigenous cultures, deer were revered as sacred, gentle beings

that offered spiritual guidance and symbolized regeneration and rebirth; but other tribes, particularly those of the Eastern woodlands, feared the Deer Woman, a supernatural, shape-shifting entity that lured men to their death.

Meanwhile, pure white deer frolic through various folklore, where a sighting might signify good fortune or a portent of change and challenges ahead. According to Arthurian legend, a white stag often appeared in the forests around King Arthur's court, compelling the knights to battle gods and fairies.





# CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

DID YOU KNOW THAT THERE was once an eagle kept captive in a cage where the Cortland Standard building stands today?

Around 1828, an eagle was captured by John C. Kinney on his father's farm on the Kinney Gulf Road. Young John sold the eagle to William Bassett, a jeweler in Cortland. Mr. Bassett then sold the bird to General Roswell Randall who owned a large tract of land that included the present-day Cortland Standard block, and his grand home was situated on that parcel.

Randall was a successful businessman, and his store was on the opposite corner from his home. Mr. Bassett had commissioned a large cage made for the bird when he owned it, and that cage was alternately displayed on Roswell Randall's front lawn and on a small triangle of grass in front of his store (where the clocktower building is today).

During the especially exuberant Fourth of July celebration of 1831, General Randall set the eagle free. In "Stories of Cortland County," author Bertha Blodgett guessed that perhaps either Randall was tired of trying to tame the eagle or that he felt bad keeping the symbol of American liberty captive in a cage. We'll never know for sure, but we do know that Randall asked Mr. Bassett to fashion a silver band to attach to the eagle's leg before it was released. The inscription read "To Henry Clay, Louisville, Ky, from William Bassett of Cortland Villa., Cortland Co., N.Y."

The eagle was taken to the top of the cupola of the Eagle Hotel and released. A huge crowd watched as the eagle flapped its wings three times before taking to the air and circling a few times. Unfortunately, this story has a sad ending because the eagle was shot on a high bluff near the Mississippi River on July 11, 1831. The silver band is said to have been returned to the Randall family, but where it is today is unknown.
