JOHN J. McGraw has long been considered the greatest manager in baseball history.

Thanks to the work and dedication of a local resident, a new historical marker will be installed in Truxton, NY on August 2, 2025. William Swisher, a resident of the area since 1966, and his wife Sarah have funded and designed a historical marker to memorialize the John J. McGraw baseball field and grandstand in Truxton. Billed as the "Greatest Sporting Event in the History of Cortland County," the marker is a tribute to a professional baseball game played there on August 8, 1938. An event has been planned to commemorate the game, which will include the unveiling of the historical marker, replication of activities from the 1938 game and speeches by local representatives. A local exhibition baseball game will be played following the formal event. Production and music for the event will be provided by Songs of the Game.







CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

ID YOU KNOW THAT GINSENG <mark>was once grown as a cash crop in</mark> $^\prime$ Cortland County? Ginseng root is highly prized in Asian countries and was exported from areas of North America as early as 1720. Ginseng was prevalent in deciduous hardwood forests, preferring well drained soil and a shady habitat, but farmers discovered that they could cultivate ginseng under proper conditions.

Several farmers in the county developed systems to successfully grow ginseng in quantities large enough to provide a good supplemental income. One of the places ginseng was grown was in Scott by the Barber family, though it was also cultivated in Homer. Carefully prepared beds measuring four to five feet wide and up to thirty feet long were set up under canopies created by posts and lath to shade the tender plants from the sun and simulate forest conditions. An old scrapbook from the Barber family contains directions on how to prepare the beds and build the shade system.

In the years 1821-1899, U.S. exports of wild ginseng totaled 30,105,572 pounds with a peak in the 1880s. Such extreme harvesting contributed to a decline in the availability of wild ginseng, and there have been regulations established at both the federal and state level to protect this plant. Ginseng farmers were doing well until a significant blight befell the plants around 1910. Both wild and cultivated ginseng were affected, and it has become increasingly difficult to find or grow the plants in the years since.

CREATURE FEATURE WHOOO'S A CUTE BABY?

PHOTOGRAPHER FRIEND RECENTLY SHARED the photo shown Ahere, that of an adorable **Barred Owl** chick looking as though it's been generously rolled in cotton batting. This awkward youngster is perhaps around 6 weeks old, and although it is still being cared for by its parents, it has left the nest and is exhibiting a developmental behavior known as 'branching'.

Like many other bird species, Barred Owl chicks grow rapidly. As they continue to develop, their activity level increases and so does their independence -- this includes learning to fly and exploring their forest environment. Eventually, the chicks will begin foraging and hunting for themselves. Still, it's not unusual for them to hang around the nest area for another 6 months.

Note that an owlet observed on the ground isn't necessarily cause for concern or intervention. It depends on the chick's age and circumstances. For example, is it well-feathered; are the parents caring for it; is there an obvious injury; did you witness it being attacked by another animal; etc. When in doubt, leave it be and observe from afar to help determine the situation. If you think the bird requires intervention, call a licensed wildlife rehabilitator for guidance.
