





ITHACA DIRT RIDERS 53RD ANNUAL SPRINT ENDURO SUNDAY, AUGUST 17

TN THE EARLY 1970's, A small group of local off-road motorcycle Lenthusiasts came together to form the Ithaca Dirt Riders (IDR). It was their vision to provide some local trails and events for their club members and other to enjoy. A year later, the club chartered with the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA). With many of its member interested in the AMA sport of enduros, the club sanctioned its first event. This year is the 53rd anniversary of The Ithaca Dirt Riders Enduro! There are NO spectator fees, but there is lots of chances to see your favorite rider during the event. A food truck will be on hand on Sunday and there is free primitive camping! With the help of many volunteers and supporters, the Ithaca Dirt Riders have not only been able to host this local event, but many AMA national events over the





years. IDR not only promote the sport of off-road riding but also helps the local communities.

SO, WHAT IS A SPRINT ENDURO? Enduros are a cross-country event, which not only requires speed and ability, but also endurance (hence "Enduro").

With a Sprint Enduro, the timekeeping element is not a factor. Fairly new to the enduro world in America, sprint enduros allow competitors to race against the clock on wide, fast-flowing trails and grass track. They ride a small number of special tests multiple times throughout the day, trying to improve their times each ride. There is a time limitation to complete the required test section or tests. The rider with the fastest time to complete the loops wins.

CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

THE DAIRY INDUSTRY HAS BEEN an important part of the cattle to this area in the 1790s. Every part of life revolved around agriculture and animal husbandry because both were essential to life, and each family member had a role to play in the successful operation of a homestead. Food cultivation and preservation were vital to survival from one harvest until the next, so it was important to put up enough food for your family for about a year.

Our ancestors used many methods to preserve food, and surplus milk was something they preserved, but how? Cows can produce 6 or more gallons a milk per day-that's a lot of milk to deal at a time when there was no refrigeration! Did you know that making cheese for sale or barter was a critical part of life in the 1800s? Cheesemaking provided farmers a way to procure other things they could not produce such as shoes or flour. In fact, cheese factories sprung up in every community.

In Virgil, the Virgil Agricultural Society was formed in 1854 for the purpose of holding a fair. After two or three years of successful fairs, it was thought that a large cheese might be made to entice even more people to attend the fair. Virgil farmers contributed curd for the endeavor, and the cheese was created using the tire of a wagon wheel, pressed in a cider mill, and turned by a machine which had been created specifically for the task. It was presented at the Fair and weighed more than 500 pounds! Each of the farmers who had furnished curd to make the cheese divided the monster cheese amongst them. Though the giant cheese had indeed contributed to high attendance at the fair, the organization of fairs in other communities eventually had the effect of diminishing attendance at the Virgil Fair, causing it to cease in 1864.
