





CREATURE FEATURE HOW DO THEY KNOW?


Many of our feathered friends have already begun their autumn migration. Do you ever wonder how they know where to go? Avian migration is one of the most intriguing phenomena of the natural world; and while much of it remains shrouded in mystery, ornithologists continue to learn more about the different ways birds navigate during their arduous journeys that often span oceans and continents.

Daytime migrants use natural features for landmarks such as rivers and mountain ranges to help map their course, while nocturnal travelers rely on the moon and stars as guides. The rising and setting of the sun provides birds with other directional clues. It's also likely that certain species of seabirds use their sense of smell to guide them across wide expanses of water devoid of visual landmarks.

It's mind-boggling how juvenile birds from a wide variety of species make their first migration without any guidance from their parents. Scientists believe they hatch with genetic programming that provides some baseline knowledge on where they must go; then, as they gain experience, their travel route gets "fine-tuned."

Perhaps most intriguing of all is how birds seem to have the ability to detect and use the Earth's magnetic field to help them navigate during migration. Exactly how they do this remains a mystery that scientists continue to ponder.



Touch is the first sense to develop in humans and is usually the last to fade.



CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

ID YOU KNOW THAT ONE of Cortland County's most famous citizens held the record for the longest recording career? Trombonist Newell "Spiegle" Willcox made his first recording in 1923 and his last in 1999, clocking in an unbelievable 76year recording career!

Spiegle was born in Sherburne, NY on May 2, 1903, to Lynn Dee and May Newell Willcox. The family took up residence in Cortland where Lynn founded the Willcox & Son Coal and Oil Co. Spiegle's father taught him how to play the valve trombone, and father and son played in the Cortland YMCA band. While in the Manlius Military Academy, Spiegle started playing the slide trombone which is the instrument he was known for throughout his lengthy career.

During the 1920s, Willcox made the connections that would have a lasting impact on his music career. One of the bands that connected him to some of the noted musicians of this decade was the Jean Goldkette Orchestra. Willcox played with Bix Beiderbeck, one of the most influential cornet players of the jazz genre.

He played throughout Central New York and was a staple on the local music scene. In 1975, he was part of a reunion of the Jean Goldkette band at Carnegie Hall, and this led to the renewal of Spiegle's music career. The next twenty-five years, he played regularly throughout the United States and Europe, collected an honorary degree from SUNY Cortland, won the Benny Carter Award of the American Federation of Jazz Societies, and was selected for the Hall of Fame for the 1993 Syracuse SAMMY Awards which was the first year the awards were held.
