CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

ORTLAND COUNTY WAS HOME TO David Hannum, one of the biggest jokesters in American history, and his story is widely known, but did you know that there was a purely

fabricated story involving General Roswell Randall's carriage that quickly became legendary throughout New York state?

In 1889, Governor David B. Hill was the guest of honor at the State Fair, which was held in Elmira that year. A call went out to secure the stately Randall carriage from Cortland to convey the governor around the fair. Some jokers in Cortland concocted an impressive "history" for the carriage, which they shared with the newspapers in Elmira, and a myth was born!

It was said that the carriage was built in Paris in 1770 and brought to America by a French general who was accompanied by LaFayette during the Revolutionary War. It was afterward presented to Alexander Hamilton who then passed it along to William Cooper, the father of author James Fenimore Cooper. The Cooper family used it for several years before William willed the carriage to Roswell Randall. After that, it passed to James Schermerhorn before finally being purchased in 1888 by H.D. Freer, the owner of the Taughannock Falls hotel.

This story was impressive enough to have been repeatedly shared by papers across the state, but the true story is that Roswell Randall purchased the carriage around 1828, and it was used by his family. It was dark green with matching upholstery, and it remained in the family for decades. William Pendleton Randall purchased the carriage from his father Roswell in 1834 and used it for his wedding journey to New Jersey and back. Billy P., as he was known, owned several stagecoach lines and a livery in Cortland. He was a dealer in fine horses, and after years of family use, he put the carriage into his stable for public use until it became outdated and was set aside in the stable.

James Schermerhorn, mentioned in the fabricated story, had a son named A.M. Schermerhorn who opened a carriage repository next to the Randall livery. He bought the carriage, refinished it, and added advertising streamers for his business to the sides. Billy P. Randall was indignant that the carriage was being used in such a manner! H.D. Freer was the next owner, but the whereabouts of the storied carriage (or if it is even still tucked away somewhere) is unknown.



CREATURE FEATURE PLEASE BEE KIND

The summer and fall are a critical time period for bees. Colonies are at their peak population, meaning there are more bees foraging and defending their hives than at any other time of the year.

Bumble bees are perhaps our most recognizable bee. Of the numerous species occurring in the United States, the most

ubiquitous is the aptly named Common Eastern Bumble Bee -- that familiar fuzzy-wuzzy with the all-black head, yellow middle, and black rear end. Common Bumble Bees can be very small (workers), fairly large (queens), or somewhere in between (drones). Their populations peak in September, and individuals can be observed actively foraging for nectar and pollen through October and even into November.

Unlike honey bees that overwinter in a community hive or tree cavity, bumble bee workers die in late fall. Only mated queens will overwinter; and in late autumn they seek sheltered, subterranean places to hibernate, such as nooks beneath rocks and under fallen leaves. You can help support queen bees by resisting the urge to cut back spent flower stalks or disturb the soil by raking leaves. Consider these "messy" areas royal chambers, because bumble bee queens while adapted to withstand the cold -- rely on suitable habitat to survive through winter. So this fall, please "bee kind!"




