





# STONE BY STONE HOW HARRY COLEMAN BROUGHT LIFE BACK TO DWYER PARK

When visitors cook their meals in scenic Dwyer Park in Preble, NY many do not realize the amount of

painstaking labor that went into restoring the 1950s cobblestone fireplaces that dot its landscape.





For the past 8 years, Harry Coleman of Homer has rebuilt 20 of the long neglected and deteriorating fireplaces. Nine of them were totally unusable. As a retired union mason, Harry was no stranger to the artistry of cobblestone stonework.

The fireplaces, originally built in the 1950s as part of a public works initiative, had been a central figure of the park. Over time weather and wear took their toll and many of the structures began to crumble. Harry knew that he could bring them back to life and usefulness.

Harry's generous volunteer spirit along with his skilled craftsmanship and dedication to the past has brought back generations of memories and warmed the hearts of those who spent and currently spend countless hours cooking with family and friends and making family memories on these treasures.

For years, Harry has quietly dedicated his time, skills, and heart to restoring one of the county's hidden treasures — from rebuilding historic cobblestone fireplaces, stone lamposts and the flagpole base to preserving the park's legacy for future generations. His story is a powerful reminder that some of the most meaningful contributions often go unseen — but never unfelt.

Cortland County owns Dwyer Memorial Park. Harry's impact and legacy is etched in stone and he has left a lasting mark on the park. However formal recognition has never come. Suggestions have been to name the newly built pier after him.









# **CHILLER HAUNTED HOUSE**

As a CHILD, CHILLER HAUNTED House creator Jim Coon, always loved the scary dark rides that lined the midway of the New York State Fair... at least from the outside. "I would never go in," Coon says, "but I was always fascinated with the hand painted panels depicting ghosts and monsters."

Coon has always had a penchant for "scary stuff".

"I would spend Saturday afternoons at my grandparents house and at 1:00 sharp the TV would get turned over to Monster Movie Matinee."

Coon would spend his Saturdays watching the old black and white horror movies. Giant insects, space aliens and Vincent Price were regular companions on winter afternoons.

"I blame my parents for my love of horror movies." Coon states. One of his earliest childhood memories was staying up late on Saturday nights to watch Chiller Theater. "I remember so many of those movies scared me as a child but I just kept coming back for more."

His love of all things scary, though, ended outside the haunted houses and dark rides. "I would never go in." he says. " When I was little my dad took me to a haunted house and a man in a pumpkin mask jumped out and started yelling at me, WHO TOOK MY PUMPKINS! DID YOU TAKE MY PUMPKINS? That was it for me. I cried the rest of the way through. I later found out the Pumpkin Man was a neighbor. Whether he felt any remorse over making a 4 year old cry I don't know."

At 16 Coon worked his first haunted house at the Cortland Fairgrounds. "I was a werewolf" he says" and I was in a cage and as people would turn the corner I would lunge at them and howl. I knew then I enjoyed being on that side of the scare."

That same year, Coon with the help of his Dad created his first haunted house in the family garage and what started as Davey's Dungeon became The Chiller Haunted House now in it's 43rd year. The haunt has moved over the years starting on Lamont Drive to Madison Street. Then onto the Burch Building in Suggett Park in Cortland and then to The Center for the Arts of Homer. In 2023 the haunt moved back to Madison Street.

"I'm 58 now and though I still enjoy creating and building the haunt...well, I'm not as young as I used to be." Coon says with a smile.

The haunt began as a place for neighborhood kids to come to and get a quick scare along with their candy but it's legacy has become more than that.

"I ran into a friend's younger brother the other day and he told me how he remembers going through the haunt and how so many of the Lamont Circle kids remember Halloween nights because of the little free haunted house my family put on every year. He told me how special it was and to hear that is what makes doing the haunt all worth it. It keeps me pushing year after year and hopefully I can make it to 50 years."

If you would like a little scare yourself, The Chiller Haunted House will be open this year October 30th from 7:00pm - 9:00pm for a non-scary/low scare tour. Only animatronics and limited live actors on this night. Then on Halloween night, October 31 from 6:00pm - 10:00pm the Haunt opens with a full compliment of ghosts and ghouls for hair raising tours through "The House of Nightmares" which is this year's theme. Admission is free but donations are accepted.



# **CREATURE FEATURE FALLING FOR LEAVES**

Every leaf speaks bliss to me Fluttering from the autumn tree.

-Emily Brontë

THE PINNACLE OF AUTUMN IS found in the changing of the L leaves, the beauty of which has been the muse inspiring countless poets striving to capture the season's aesthetic essence, as well as the introspective mood that often accompanies it.

In spring and summer, leaves absorb sunlight like mini solar panels and turn its energy into food using chlorophyll—the green pigment found in most leaves. In autumn, however, leaves begin to reveal their hidden yellow, red, and orange pigments as chlorophyll fades in response to the shorter days and cooler temperatures.

Which color leaves turn depends on the types of pigments they contain. Carotenoids produce yellow and orange leaves, while anthocyanins create red or purple hues. Science aside, the result is breathtaking, as maple, ash, birch, aspen, hickory, beech, oak, and other hardwoods produce a kaleidoscope of color. Eventually, the pigments responsible for the breathtaking display break down, leaving behind tannins; and the leaves fade to brown.

Throughout this process, leaves form an abscission layer at their base, which weakens their connection to the branch and ultimately causes them to detach and fall to the ground. Most trees are left bare, harkening back to how autumn, despite its profound beauty, can evoke bittersweet feelings as we contemplate the imminent arrival of winter. As Robert Frost mused, "O hushed October morning mild, The leaves have ripened to the fall; Tomorrow's wind, if it be wild, Should waste them all.

# **CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA** DID YOU KNOW?

lacktriang elebrating milestones is an important  $\operatorname{part}$  of → community building, and Cortland County totally outdid itself in 1958 for the 150th anniversary of the birth of our county. Did you know that the sesquicentennial celebration was planned in less than a year and that it encompassed an entire week of activities?

On November 29, 1957, at an open meeting of the Cortland County Historical Society, the decision was made to have a celebration to mark the 150th anniversary of Cortland County, and the Cortland County Chamber of Commerce was asked to sponsor this commemorative event. The festivities would take place July 20-26, 1958, and a 300+ page Souvenir Book that covered 150 years of county history was to be compiled. This was a massive undertaking in such a short period of time, but the committees worked diligently to move the entire project forward, and with a dedicated team that stretched across the county, it was a resounding success!

When you look over the official schedule of events for the weeklong celebration, it is beyond impressive. There were baseball games, parades, banquets, barbeques, block dances, fireworks, luncheons, microd racing, pageants, contests, competitions, concerts, and a soapbox derby race scheduled. The newly constructed armory was dedicated and a military ball held there. The National Guard was on hand to assist with the dedication while Spiegle Willcox and his orchestra was secured to provide music for dancing. At the end of the week, the Sesquicentennial Queen was selected and crowned.

The work that went into the events of the sesquicentennial was phenomenal. Police estimated that there were 30,000 people at the parade through Cortland! The parade had 106 entries, 60 of which were floats. Wooden nickels and bowtie souvenirs were some of the commemorative items available, and many people in the community today fondly recall the big event.


