



screech owl whinnies and trills; and the northern saw-whet makes repetitive flute-like whistles, "toot-toot, toot-toot, toot-toot...!"

Although each species is unique, owls share some commonalities. Firstly, tube-shaped eyes provide super-sharp focus but prevent their eyes from moving in their sockets; Consequently, owls must turn their heads to track movement -- but since they can rotate their heads up to 270 degrees, this is no problem! Owls also have asymmetrical ears that pinpoint sounds with astounding precision. As well, they can fly in near silence, thanks to specialized soft-edged feathers, making them super stealthy.

Since owls hunt and eat A LOT of rodents, they are extremely susceptible to rodenticide poisoning. Poisoned mice and rats are easy to catch, and when owls swallow them, they suffer fatal internal hemorrhaging. If you give a hoot about owls, please show them some love by saying "NO" to rodenticides.

CREATURE FEATURE OWL ALWAYS LOVE YOU

WHOO DOESN'T LOVE OWLS? FROM pint-sized hooters on up to those bearing a looming presence, these enchanting raptors have captured our hearts. Over 230 owl species are found on every continent except Antarctica. Yes, owls are all around us, but due to their nocturnal behaviors, cryptic plumage, and reclusive ways, we rarely detect their presence.

Winter is a good time to look for owls. They spend most of the daytime perched quietly, but often leave behind clues pointing to their favorite roosting tree: telltale signs like splashes of white guano on the trunk or regurgitated 'owl pellets' on the ground (clumps of undigested bones and fur). Winter is also a good time to listen for owls, when certain species - like the great horned owl pictured here - grow more vocal as they renew pair bonds. During this time, enamored mates call back and forth in passionate duets. Note though, that not all owls hoot! For example, the barn owl screeches; the eastern

CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

DO YOU KNOW THE STORY of the first wedding in Cincinnatus? Dr. John McWhorter was one of the first white settlers to the wilds of Cincinnatus in the late 1790s. At that time, the town was still part of Onondaga County and was thickly forested and teeming with wolves, bears, and panthers. The only roads were footpaths used by the Indigenous peoples in the region, so travel was difficult and settlement was slow in the valley.

From amongst the settler families, Dr. McWhorter met Catharine Young, and it wasn't long before they planned to be married. A date was set, arrangements were made, and a celebration prepared. Because of the difficult traveling conditions, attendees started out days before the ceremony was to take place so they would arrive in time. A minister from nearby Oxford was hired to perform the nuptials.

John and Catharine and their guests were assembled in Cincinnatus, ready to begin the wedding ceremony when someone suddenly questioned whether a minister from Chenango County could perform a wedding in Cortland County. The minister agreed that his license was only good in Chenango County, so they formed a caravan of ox carts to transport the bride, groom, and guests to a locale over the county line so the marriage would be valid. It was discovered later that they hadn't gone far enough to reach the county line! The couple had yet another wedding to ensure they were legally married!

Dr. McWhorter was appointed the first surrogate in Cortland County when the county was set apart from Onondaga County on April 8, 1808. He became a prominent and respected citizen of Cincinnatus and even built a hotel in Lower Cincinnatus in 1833. John and Catharine went on to have a family of nine children, several of whom died relatively young. The twice married couple are both at rest in the Lower Cincinnatus Cemetery.



FETTUCCHINE AL BURRO (FETTUCCHINE WITH BUTTER)

DO YOU LOVE FETTUCCHINI ALFREDO, but hate how heavy it is and how full you feel afterwards? This is for you! This dish is the original alfredo created by, well, Alfredo! Alfredo Di Lelio created the dish between 1908 and 1914 as a light but nourishing meal for his wife after she had given birth. It was so popular it became a staple at his restaurant in Rome named Alfredo alla Scrofa where it is still served to this day! The alfredo we eat today was brought to America by several famous actors of the time, Mary Pickford and Douglas Fairbanks, after eating at Alfredo's restaurant in the 1920's growing quickly to the velvety, creamy dish we know and love today!

- 1 pound fettuccine or pappardelle pasta
- 3/4 cup (1 1/2 sticks) unsalted butter, cut into 1-inch pieces, at room temperature (Do not heat let come to room temperature naturally!!)
- 2 cups freshly grated parmesan cheese
- Salt & Pepper to taste

Bring a large pot of water to a boil. Season it generously with salt. Add the pasta to the water and stir immediately. Cook, stirring often, to prevent the pasta from sticking to itself.

Meanwhile, in a large bowl, place the butter and 1 cup of parmesan cheese. When the pasta is al dente, 9 or 10 minutes, use tongs to remove the pasta from water directly to the bowl with the butter along with 1/4 cup of the pasta water. Toss the pasta well to melt the butter and coat the pasta in the sauce. Add the remaining cup of cheese along with another 1/4 to 1/2 cup pasta water if needed to maintain a sauce. Taste it and season with a pinch of salt if needed. Serve immediately topped with additional cheese and a crack of black pepper.


