





#### A FAMILY TREE **WITH DEEP ROOTS -CELEBRATING 60 YEARS**

THUTE'S WATER SYSTEMS AND SHUTE'S LaFayette Well Drilling has been a family-run business serving Central New York for 60 years, drilling wells, installing pumps and treating problem water.

Originally known as LaFayette Well Drilling, established in 1963 by Howard Shute, and brother-in-law, Warren Shetler, both the business and their reputation grew over the years. Shute continued on with the business after Shetler decided to pursue other interests.

Shute was then joined by his sons, Mark, Neil and Scott. Howard Shute retired at nearly 80 years of age while his sons continued the family tradition of providing safe and pure water to the community.

Today, Shute's Water Systems is run by Scott Shute and Matt Farkas, and Shute's Excavation is run by Todd Shute. Scott's wife Becky runs the office with Mark Shute's daughter Jill. The family attributes the majority of its continued success from recommendations it receives from satisfied customers.

Shute said many municipal water systems contain calcium and magnesium, which as "hard" substances, form scale and create problems in water heaters, dish washers and plumbing systems.

Water purification can include the removal of iron, sulfur, chlorine and bacteria in a chemicalfree process. Softening the water is also important and has many benefits, not only for family members, but for plumbing systems and appliances too.

"Uncontaminated water is essential for good health," Shute said. "Foul-smelling or unusual

odors from your water should make you question your water's quality and safety."

Many families throughout Central New York use well water as a source of drinking water and for all its household needs. Unfortunately, water containing hydrogen sulfide gas has a distinctive "rotten egg" odor which is especially noticeable when running hot water.

Shute said the danger lies in a gradual chemical

"Hydrogen sulfide gas will corrode plumbing metals such as iron, steel, copper and brass, and the exposed metal parts in appliances such as dishwashers and washing machines" Shute said. "Also, corrosion of iron and steel pipes from ferrous sulfide, or 'black water,' that can darken everyday tableware, discolor copper and brass utensils and alter the appearance and taste of cooked foods."

Additionally, Shute said, sulfur water can make washing clothes more difficult.

Shute's Water Systems can assure customers that these hazards and more can be avoided or remedied using its time-tested, ecological systems

#### **CREATURE FEATURE** A WINTER'S TALE

RADITIONALLY, ONE WAY THE IROQUOIS people L celebrated the Winter Solstice was by playing the Bowl Game, which used a number of stones painted black on one side and white on the other. The stones were put into a special, flat-bottomed wooden bowl. Players took turns tossing the rocks by banging the bowl against the floor, and depending on how the stones landed -black or white sides up -- their turn was either a win or a fail.

As the nights were so long, cold, and dark, Winter was also a time of great story-telling for the Iroquois. One such story tells how Grandmother

Moon was very displeased with the way things were going on Earth and decided that all life would end. When the Good Spirit, protector of the Iroquois people, heard this, he asked how the world might be spared. Grandmother Moon replied, "We will play the Bowl Game, and the one who wins will decide whether or not life continues."

The Good Spirit next sought out the Chickadees. He explained his idea to use them instead of stones in the bowl, since their heads were black on one side and white on the other. The Chickadees quickly agreed to help, and when the Good Spirit shook the bowl, the little birds flew into the air like tossed stones. They fluttered back down into the bowl, landing in such a way to secure a perfect score for him, thus saving the Earth from destruction.

And that is why. even today, we hear bright voices of Chickadees singing in Winter as they celebrate the continuance of life.

ID YOU KNOW THAT CORTLAND County was served by a trolley car from 1882 until 1931? This system began as a horse drawn trolley,

which was an improvement over the omnibuses and stagecoaches of the day which were being used to transport folks short distances within the community. The Cortland & Homer Horse Railroad provided a smooth ride over steel tracks, quite the improvement from the rough traveling conditions people were used to. It wasn't long before horses were replaced with electric trolley cars, and the name of the business changed to the Cortland & Homer Traction Company in 1894.

At its heyday, the trolley ran from McGraw to Little York and was a terrific way for people to get to work or to go on social calls. The Cortland Traction Company built two different parks to stimulate business for their growing enterprise. Cortland Park was built first and Little York Park was built second. These parks provided a destination for locals to picnic and socialize at, all while paying the trolley company to transport them there and home again.

Better roads, a booming automobile industry, and bus lines contributed to the demise of the trolley in Cortland County. The trolley days of Cortland ended in 1931, but you can still visit Dwyer Park at Little York and imagine what it must have been like when hundreds of people spent summer days at the Pavilion built there by the Traction Company over one hundred years
