








they updated their website aiellosrestaurant. com and were the first local restaurant in Whitney Point to offer their own online ordering, dine-in or pickup.

CREATURE FEATURE SPRING & SUMMER ALIVE WITH WILDLIFE

THE SPRING AND SUMMER SEASONS are busy times of year for wildlife as they establish territory, choose mates and raise families.

Each spring, the incessant courtship song of mourning doves fills the air: "Coo-ooo, coo, coo, coo!" The male doves try to impress the females by flying upward on noisy wingbeats before banking into a circular glide. On the ground, they sidle up to the ladies, puffing out their chests while bowing and cooing earnestly. Mated pairs may engage in mutual preening. Sometimes, mourning doves will choose a nest site around human structures, such as a hanging flower basket near a porch entry.

By the end of April, little brown bats are back on the wing, flapping around the evening skies hunting mosquitoes and other flying insects. The female bats emerge first, leaving their wintering hibernacula in humid caves and abandoned mines; male bats emerge later, some as late as May or early June. Don't be afraid of these little bats, but rather be afraid for them as this species has suffered tremendous population losses from white-nose syndrome. Besides, little brown bats can eat up to 1,200 insects in an hour and that makes them a friend, indeed!

Common loons are most vocal during spring and summer, and their haunting vocalizations can be communicated over long distances. Loons produce four main calls. The mournful sounding "wail" helps pairs stay connected and to locate lost chicks; the "tremolo," which sounds like maniacal laughter, serves as a threat signal; the "hoot" is a soft, clipped call often used for short range communication between a family unit or during low-level territorial engagements; and the "yodel," a forceful, repetitive vocalization given only by male loons, is territorial in nature. Interestingly, when a male loon changes his territory, he will also change his yodel call.

Here's hoping your spring and summer are full of pleasant adventures. While traveling, keep an eye out for wildlife on the roadways, especially turtles, which will be looking for places to lay their eggs. If you should encounter a baby animal on its own, resist the urge to intervene unless it is injured or in distress - if so, seek guidance from a wildlife rehabilitator or veterinarian.
