washcloth-type effect that helps remove fish slime from its plumage.

This handsome bird is also an excellent hunter. For sure, not much escapes the sharp sight or lightning-fast strike of the stealthy Great Blue Heron, and it will catch and eat fish, frogs, reptiles, rodents, insects, and sometimes other birds. It can even hunt successfully at night.

The Great Blue Heron has a fanciful list of nicknames almost as long as its neck, including Big Cranky, Long Tom, Old Gray, Blue Crane, Poor Joe, Shag Poke, and Big Blue Boy; and in parts of the Deep South, all Great Blue Herons are simply called Fred—with affection, of course!

**CREATURE FEATURE**  
**THE GREAT BLUE HERON:**  
**FACTS & FANCY**

**T**HE GREAT BLUE HERON is a familiar sight, as it silently stalks the rim of area lakes, ponds, and wetlands. This statuesque wading bird is often misidentified as a crane, but is in fact North America's largest heron species. It can stand over four feet tall with a six-foot wingspan, but typically weighs just five or six pounds on account of its hollow bones.

Another neat fact about the Great Blue Heron is that it has specialized, continuously-growing chest feathers that fray into a powder. During preening, the heron uses a unique fringed claw on its middle toe to distribute the powder in a

## RED, WHITE & BLUE TRIFLE

- 1 angel food cake (About 12 ounces, store bought or homemade)
- 2 pounds strawberries
- 12 ounces blueberries
- 3 tablespoons granulated sugar
- 1 pint heavy whipping cream
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

Place your bowl and whisk for the whipped cream in the freezer for 20 minutes while you prepare the rest of the ingredients.

Remove the tops from the strawberries and dice into cubes. If you are making the strawberry stars for garnish, make those first so you can use the prettiest parts of the strawberries. To make the stars, cut a strawberry in half and use a small star shaped cookie cutter to cut out a star shape. Cut as many as you need. Scraps can be tossed in with the diced strawberries. Set the strawberry stars aside. With the rest of the diced strawberries, toss with 1 tablespoon of granulated sugar and set aside for 30 minutes to macerate.

Cut or tear the angel food cake into 1/2 inch cubes. If making the angel food cake stars, use a small star shaped cookie cutter to cut star shapes out of a flat slice of cake. Scraps can be used in the trifle along with the cubes.

Make the whipped cream. Remove bowl and whisk from freezer. Pour in heavy whipping cream, sprinkle 2 tablespoons sugar on top, and add vanilla extract. Beat until soft peaks form (1-2 minutes in a stand mixer, 6-7 minutes by hand).

To assemble the trifles, use 6-8 small glass containers such as mason jars, drinking glasses, or wine glasses. I recommend using smaller sized glasses, about 4-6 ounces.

Cover the bottom of the glass with a layer of angel food cake cubes. Top with a layer of the macerated strawberries. Top that with a layer of whipped cream, then a layer of blueberries. Repeat until you reach the top of your glass. Top with more whipped cream and garnish with strawberry and angel food cake stars.

**CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?**

**D**ID YOU KNOW THAT THE town of Truxton was named after a military officer of the American Revolution? Truxton is part of the Military Tract, which is land that was given to soldiers for their military service during the Revolutionary War. It was originally part of the town of Fabius until Cortland County was set apart from Onondaga County in 1808. The names of towns in the Military Tract were of Greek and Roman origin, but since Truxton was divided from Fabius, it was not an original town of the Military Tract, and as such, it was named after Commodore Thomas Truxton.

Thomas Truxtun was born in 1755 near Hempstead, on Long Island. His father died when he was a child, and he was placed in the care of a family friend. At the age of twelve, young Truxtun went to sea, joining the crew of a British merchant ship. He became a skilled sailor and was in command of his own vessel by the time he was twenty. As the relationship between the colonies and Great Britain became more contentious, Truxtun was impressed into the Royal Navy. He turned down a midshipman's commission, and after he was wounded in action against an American privateer, Truxtun vowed he would not fight his own countrymen again. He became a privateer during the Revolution and captured several British ships.

A capable seaman, Truxtun spent the next dozen years sailing the world. He commanded the vessel Canton, one of the first American ships to trade with China. In the tumultuous years after the Revolution, America and France were involved in the Quasi-War, a two year undeclared war, and Truxtun was appointed by President George Washington as one of the first six captains in the United States Navy. He served admirably and was awarded a Congressional Gold Medal on March 29, 1800, for his victory against the French vessel La Vengeance.

Truxtun wrote and published several books on navigation and naval tactics, and he designed the US Navy signal manual as well as wrote the predecessor to the Navy Regulations used to this day.

A hero of his day, Truxtun was well known when the town of Truxton was formed in 1808, and though the spelling was changed when the town was named, it was an honor for a small rural town in New York to be named after a great commodore of the US Navy.


