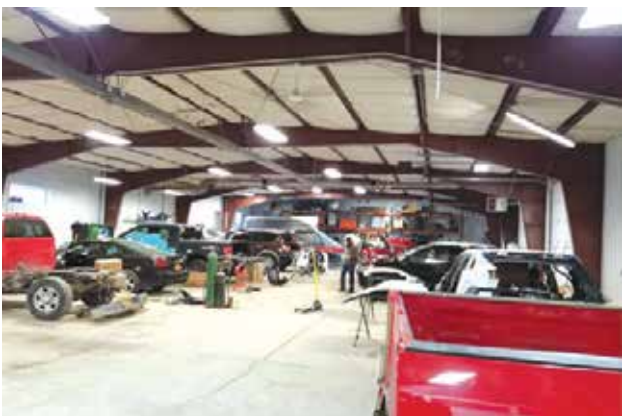

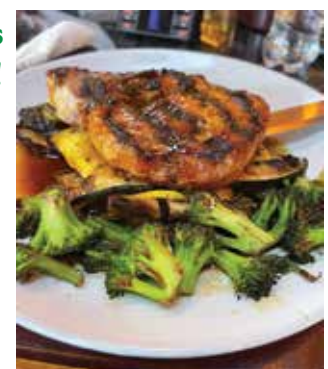

CREATURE FEATURE SUPERPOWER OWL

MEET THE **AMERICAN BARN OWL**, chief consumer of mice and rats and a farmer’s good friend. It inhabits six continents as well as many islands, making it one of the most widespread of all landbirds. Due to its ethereal, ghost-like appearance, hair-raising, raspys shrieks, and a tendency to roost in darkened haylofts and belfries, superstitions swirl around the Barn Owl. Today, however, we focus not on superstitions but rather on this bird’s impressive “superpower.”

Truly, the Barn Owl’s superpower lies in its super-sensitive hearing. It can pinpoint the location of a tiny rodent even when it is out of sight under the snow or shrouded in complete darkness. In fact, a Barn Owl can hear noises that are ten times softer than those audible to the human ear.

This is because the owl’s entire head is designed for listening. Its face is shaped like a satellite dish and rimmed by a heart-shaped ruff of stiff feathers that channel sounds towards the ears, which are hidden on either side of its face. One ear is positioned almost imperceptibly higher than the other and monitors the airwaves outward and above, while the lower ear listens for sounds from below. So in addition to incredibly sensitive hearing, the Barn Owl can listen for sounds emanating from all directions, essentially enabling it to *hear in 3-D!*

CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

TORNADOES IN CORTLAND COUNTY ARE rare, but they do occur. A particularly damaging “cyclone” raged through the county on August 21, 1890. The storm barreled into the city of Cortland just after 5pm, following a driving rain which had been falling all day. The wind picked up and seemed to come from two directions at once. According to witnesses who saw the approach of the storm, the wind developed a whirling motion which picked up and carried a large number of things as it moved over the city streets. Fallen trees littered the city, as did telephone and electric wires. Many homes were damaged throughout the city, including some which had parts of their roofs ripped off.

Several buildings on Main Street were damaged, including the new Wallace building. The brick cornice was torn off the building on the south side and “the tin raised and rolled back from the greater portion of the roof.” In addition to this damage, roof boards and beams were damaged, exposing the wallpaper inventory below to water from the relentless rain. Fifty thousand rolls of wallpaper were stored on the upper floors of the building, and employees scrambled to save it. The estimated damage was \$2,500. In addition to the Wallace building, Taylor Hall and the Calvert block sustained damages as well.

Manufacturing facilities were not spared by the storm, either. The Wickwire Wire Cloth Mills had a two-hundred-foot section of tin roofing torn of the building, followed by fifty feet of the main chimney crashing down through the roof and carrying two weaving looms to the floor below. Two employees who had been working at the looms barely escaped death. The sprinkler system was broken and caused flooding, increasing the damage to the factory. Estimated loss after the storm was \$3,000.

The most significant damage from this storm occurred at the Hitchcock Manufacturing Company whose store house was “badly wrecked” when it was picked up and carried 12-15 feet to the north before crashing down. Initial damage was estimated at \$10,000 immediately after the storm. The building was 200 feet long by 50 feet wide, two and a half stories high, and contained between two and three thousand cutters in various states of completion. Ultimately, there were 2,300 cutters in the store house and about half were damaged or destroyed. Hitchcock was able to repair many, and they opted not to rebuild the store room. Other parts of their facility were utilized to store the salvaged inventory. The reclaimed wood from the destroyed building was used to construct a number of tenant houses nearby. By mid-September, the extent of the damage to Hitchcock had been adjusted to \$6,000.

THE ULTIMATE POTATO SALAD

PERFECT TEXTURE, CREAMY & BRIGHT

Prep Time: 20 mins

Cook Time: 15 mins

Yields: 6–8 servings

- 2 lbs Yukon Gold or Red potatoes, diced into bite-sized cubes
- 1–2 tbsp apple cider vinegar
- 3/4 cup mayonnaise
- 2 tsp Dijon mustard
- 1/2 tsp celery seed
- 3 hard-boiled eggs, chopped
- 2 stalks celery, finely diced
- 3 green onions, chopped
- Sea salt and freshly cracked black pepper, to taste

1. Boil the Potatoes (15–20 minutes)

Place the diced potatoes into a large pot and cover with cold, heavily salted water. Bring to a boil over medium-high heat. Cook until fork-tender but still holding their shape.

2. The Hot Vinegar Splash (Immediately)

Drain the potatoes thoroughly in a colander. While they are still steaming hot, transfer them to a bowl and gently toss with the apple cider vinegar. This allows the potatoes to absorb the vinegar into their core. Let them cool for 15 minutes.

3. Prepare the Dressing (5 minutes)

In a separate large mixing bowl, whisk together the mayonnaise, Dijon mustard, celery seed, a generous pinch of salt, and black pepper until smooth.

4. Combine the Textures (2 minutes)

Fold the chopped hard-boiled eggs, diced celery, and chopped green onions into the dressing until evenly distributed.

5. Toss and Chill (At least 1 hour)

Gently fold the cooled, vinegar-infused potatoes into the dressing. Cover and refrigerate for at least 1 hour before serving to allow the flavors to develop.

Chef’s Secret Pro Tip

Always start your potatoes in completely cold water. If you drop them directly into boiling water, the exteriors will cook too quickly and become gummy or mushy before the centers are tender. Gradually heating the potatoes ensures a perfectly even texture every time.

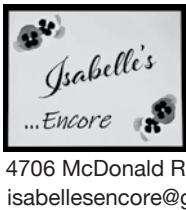
