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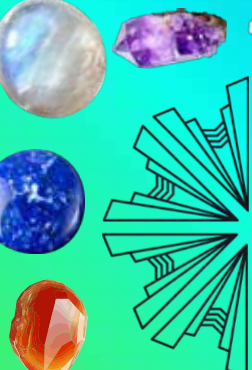
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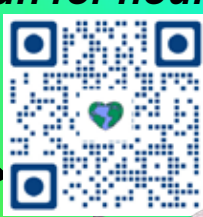

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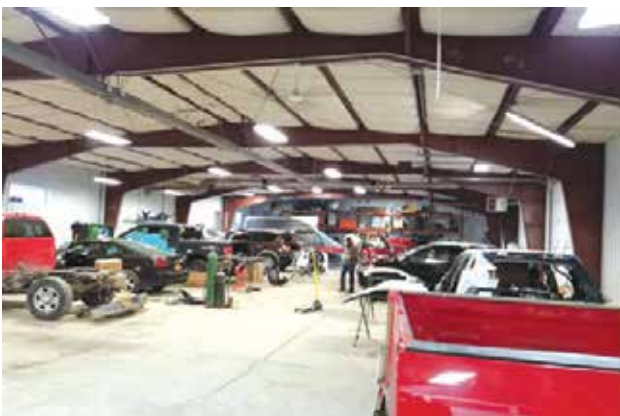

CREATURE FEATURE CELEBRATING BALD EAGLES

AS WE CONTINUE TO CELEBRATE our nation's 250th year, it seems fitting to celebrate bald eagles too.

Female bald eagles are larger than males, but both can be huge -- their bodies can measure 3 feet long with an 8-foot wingspan. Astoundingly, they can soar over 10,000 feet high. "Baldies" also have incredible eyesight and can spot fish nearly 1 mile away; and when they attack prey, they plummet downward at speeds up to 100 miles per hour.

Bald eagles build BIG nests for their young: the largest on record was 9.6 feet in diameter and 20 feet tall! Another famous baldie nest weighed over 4,000 pounds! Baby bald eagles (called eaglets) grow rapidly, gaining a half pound to pound of weight per week until they are around 9-10 weeks old. Immature birds won't fully develop their species' distinctive white head and tail (and bright yellow eyes and beak) until they are 5 years old; meanwhile, it's a transitory process as they develop an increasing amount of color change with each successive molt. These distinguishable stages of progression help avian enthusiasts estimate the age of sub-adult eagles.

Although bald eagles can live for 35 years or more in the wild, a recent landmark study found that nearly half of all the eagles tested over an 8-year period suffered from chronic lead exposure, resulting in population impacts. Please help keep these majestic symbols of America soaring high by *pledging to use lead-free fishing tackle and ammunition.*

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CNY SPEEDIE SLIDERS

Makes: 12 sliders

- 2 lbs boneless, skinless chicken thighs, cut into 1-inch cubes
- 1 cup Speedie marinade (Lupo’s or homemade)
- 12 Hawaiian slider buns
- 6 slices provolone cheese, halved
- 1 cup thinly sliced grilled onions
- 1 cup sautéed peppers (optional)
- 2 tbsp melted butter
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- 1 tsp dried parsley
- Chosen amount of speedie marinade

1. Marinate the chicken for at least 4 hours, preferably overnight.
2. Grill or sear the chicken over medium-high heat until it reaches 165°F.
3. Slice the slider buns in half and place the bottoms in a baking dish.
4. Layer on the cooked chicken, grilled onions, peppers (if using), and provolone.
5. Place the top buns on and brush with melted butter mixed with the garlic powder and parsley.

6. Bake at 350°F for 8–10 minutes, just until the cheese melts and the tops are lightly golden.
- Optional “Speedie Sauce”
- 1/2 cup mayonnaise
 - 2 tbsp Speedie marinade
 - 1 tsp Dijon mustard
 - 1 tsp lemon juice
- Mix ingredients together. Spread it on the buns before assembling or serve it on the side for dipping.

ITHACA DIRT RIDERS 54TH ANNUAL SPRINT ENDURO

AUGUST 16

IN THE EARLY 1970’s, A small group of local off-road motorcycle enthusiasts came together to form the Ithaca Dirt Riders (IDR). It was their vision to provide some local trails and events for their club members and others to enjoy. A year later, the club chartered with the American Motorcyclist Association (AMA). With many of its members interested in the AMA sport of enduros, the club sanctioned its first event. This year is the 54th anniversary of The Ithaca Dirt Riders Enduro! It will be held on Sunday, August 16 at 253 Andersen Hill Road, Berkshire, NY 13736 starting at 10:00 am. You can sign-up for the event from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm on Saturday, July 15, and on Sunday morning, from 7:30 am to 9:00 am. The sprint enduro consists of three “loops” through fields and woods. It is a great experience for riders with many technical challenges for them. Riders can ride as young as 12 years old (with on-site signed parental release form), if they have a bike with at least a 19” front tire. There are NO spectator fees, but there are many chances to see your favorite rider during the event. A food truck will be on hand on Sunday and there is free primitive camping! With the help of many volunteers and supporters, the Ithaca Dirt Riders have not only been able to host this local event, but many AMA national events over the years, along with a dual sport ride for the past two years. IDR not only promotes the sport of off-road riding but also helps the local communities.

SO, WHAT IS A SPRINT ENDURO? Enduros are a cross-country timed event, which not only requires speed and ability, but also endurance (hence “Enduro”).

With a Sprint Enduro, the timekeeping element is not a factor. Fairly new to the enduro world in America, sprint enduros allow competitors to race against the clock on wide, fast-flowing trails and grass track. They ride a small number of special tests multiple times throughout the day, trying to improve their times each ride. There is a time limitation to

complete the required test section or tests. The rider with the fastest time to complete the loops wins.

Have you ever run a harescramble or rode a motorcross event? You may want to try a sprint enduro! You will have more “time in the seat” and less traffic in the woods. Give it a try!

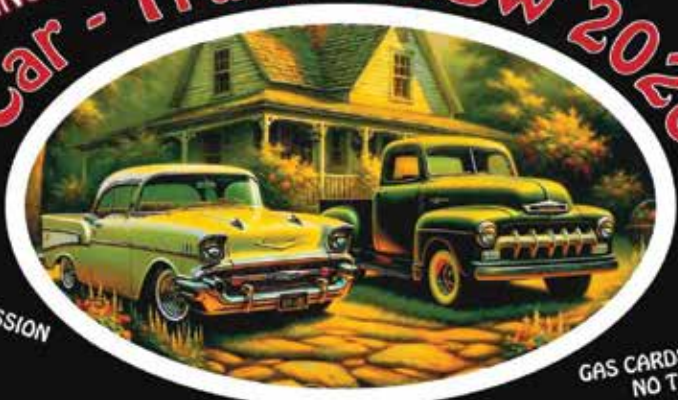

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CORTLAND COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY TRIVIA DID YOU KNOW?

ON JULY 11, 1947, THE New York Telephone Company celebrated a momentous achievement. The Cortland office had the distinct honor of installing the one millionth phone in rural Upstate New York, and that phone was installed in the home of Darius Brown whose farm sat on Lake Como Road, six miles west of Homer and about a half mile from Summerhill.

Festivities for the day began with a luncheon at the Cortland Country Club for Mr. and Mrs. Brown that was attended by friends as well as phone company and public officials. After lunch, the party arrived at the Brown home where an “amplifying system” had been set up in advance to share the event with the 200 people assembled on the lawn outside. A mile long pole line had been strung, and it was now just a matter of connecting the equipment. Special equipment was used specifically for the event, and the phone the Brown family received bore a commemorative bronze plate with an inscription as to its historical significance. The event was broadcast to local radio stations and news reels were recorded as well.

The first call made by Mr. Brown was to his friend Frank Shutts of Oneonta. Brown said, “We’re having quite a time.”

Mrs. Brown next phoned her sister in Detroit, and then the vice president of the company and general manager of the Upstate area Wellington Powell called J.J. Hanselmann, the chief of the rural development committee of the Bell System at Vergennes, Vermont. Finally, a fourth call was made by the Cortland Standard to the Associated Press at Albany to report the news.

The party continued on to Willard Straight Hall at Cornell University for a banquet and to hear from speakers and to see demonstrations of new communication developments for both wire and air. The program concluded with the audience listening to the broadcast from the Brown home earlier that day.

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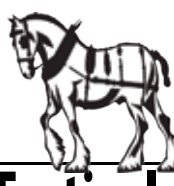
